NOVICE RIDER – Has not won more than 3 blue ribbons in any show, any division.

WALK/TROT – Riders in Walk/Trot classes may not enter any other performance classes except Walk/Trot classes.

HIGH POINT INFO

- High Point must be entered prior to your first class of the day.
- Cost to enter High Point: \$5 per High Point category.
- High Points are awarded at each show. Ribbons are awarded through 3rd place.
- End-of-Year High Points accumulate throughout the calendar year. They are awarded at the first show of the following year. Ribbons are awarded through 3rd place.

HIGH POINTS FOR JUNIOR RIDERS:

- **WALK/TROT 12 & Under** – (designated by a “T” in front of the class numbers)
Sponsored by Lori Ragland Performance Horses
- **JUNIOR EQUITATION** – (designated by “Eq” in front of the class numbers) For riders 17 and under entered in Equitation classes.
- **JUNIOR EXHIBITOR** – For riders 17 and under entered in performance and equitation classes; excludes Walk/Trot classes.

HIGH POINTS FOR ALL BREEDS:

You may select only one of these three high points per horse/per show: Hunter Pleasure, Western Pleasure, or Country Pleasure. However, you may enter Purebred Gelding and Junior High Points concurrently.

- **ARABIA/HALF-ARABIAN HUNTER PLEASURE** – denoted by an “H” in front of the class numbers

- MISCELLANEOUS POINTS** – (denoted by an * in front of class numbers); Miscellaneous points count toward Hunter Pleasure, Western Pleasure and Country Pleasure.
- **PUREBRED ARABIAN GELDING** – All Classes entered will count toward this high point.

ATTIRE & APPOINTMENTS

- Show attire is optional; however, no shorts, sleeveless tops, or tennis shoes are allowed in the show ring.
- Tack appropriate for classes is required.
- Schooling horses using training equipment will not be placed in the performance classes. If you are riding with training aids, please wear your number upside down so the judge knows you’re not to be judged.
- Sidesaddles are permissible in all under-saddle classes.
- Helmets are required for Junior riders in Hunter Pleasure.
- Helmets are recommended for all riders.

RULES OF CONDUCT

- We generally refer to the USEF competition rules as our guidelines, except where otherwise noted. This is NOT a sanctioned event, however, and the judge’s decision is final.
- Safety is paramount. Children and pets must be supervised.
- Excessive use of whip, spurs, or any other action(s) by an exhibitor, which are considered excessive by the judge and/or show management, might result in the exhibitor being ejected from the competition.
- Horses exhibiting unsafe behavior in the show ring will be excused by the judge.
- Unsafe and/or unsportsmanlike behavior by exhibitors and/or members of their party could result in ejection from the show grounds.

We want our horses and riders to compete in a safe and fun learning environment.

DIRECTIONS TO TRAVIS COUNTY EXPO CENTER

- From the south – Take IH-35 north to MLK Blvd., travel east 5.8 miles to Decker Lane (FM 3177). Go north to the Expo Center.
- From the north – Take IH-35 south to US 290, travel east 6.6 miles to Decker Lane (FM 3177). Go south 3.5 miles to Expo Center.
